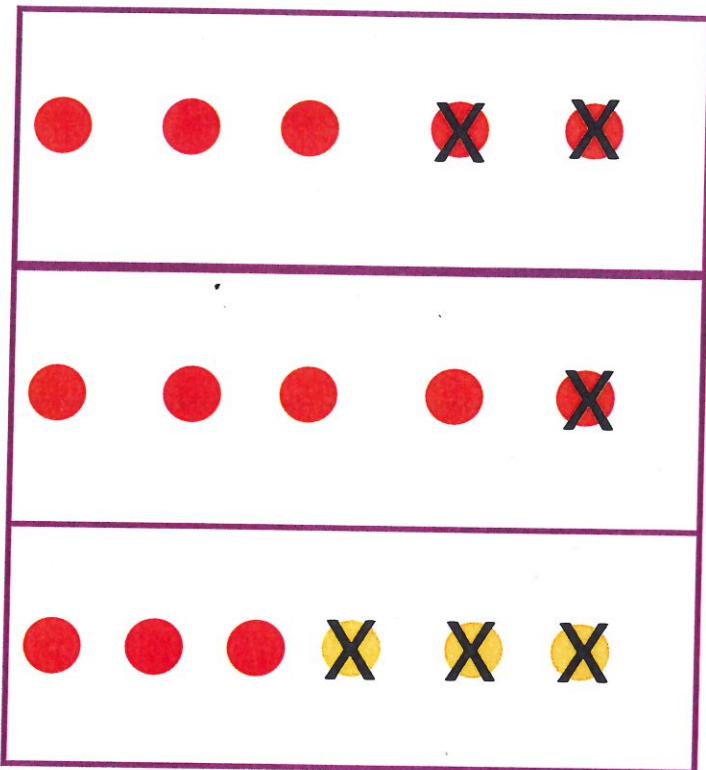


Year 1 Homework 19.10.2018
