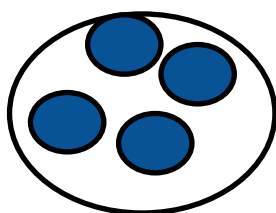
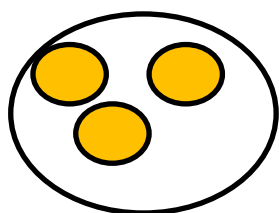
We have been learning to write using a cursive script. Each letter has a mnemonic and rhyme to help your child remember how to form it.
