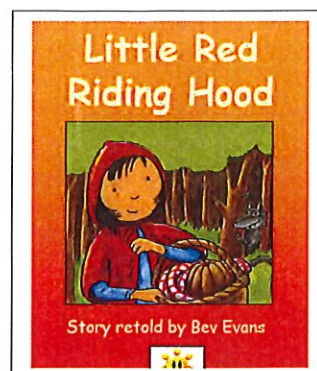


## Year 2 Homework 17.01.19

$$62 + 30$$

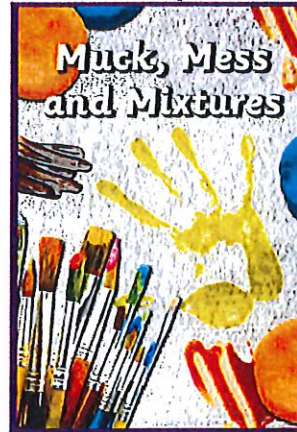
$$74 - 40$$
