

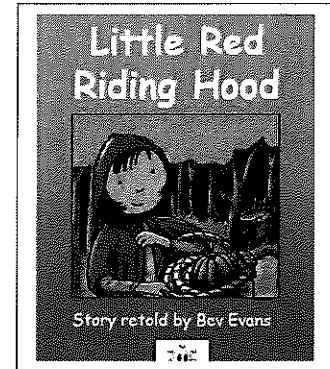

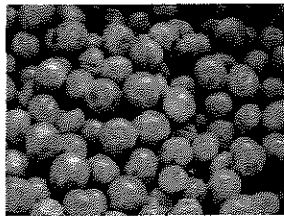
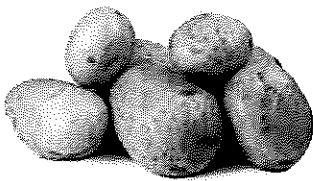

We have learnt about healthy and unhealthy food this week.

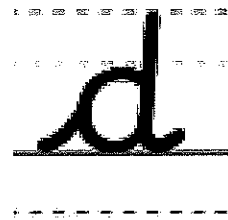
Children designed a meal using healthy food only. They are also enjoying following recipes on a Friday afternoon in our creative curriculum.
