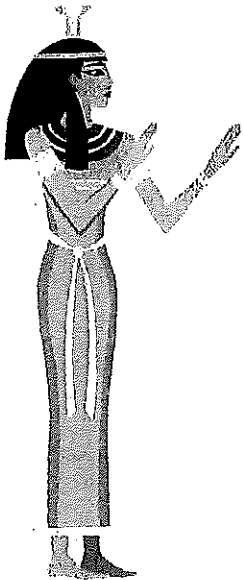

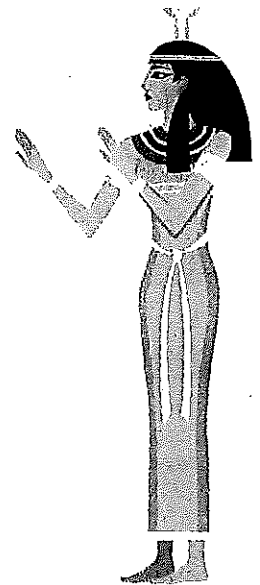
The Year 3 classroom will be turned into an Ancient Egyptian museum!

Can you make an Egyptian artefact to go in the museum?

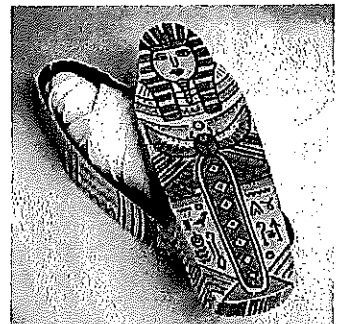
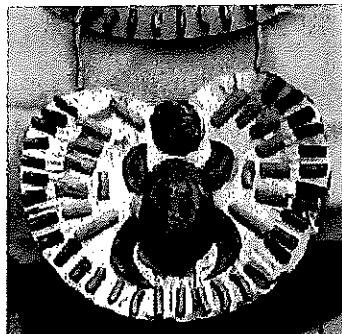
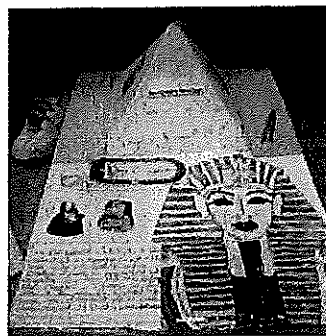
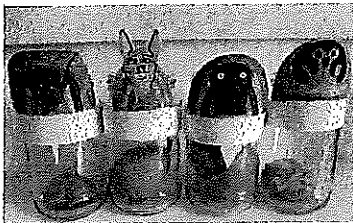


Here are some ideas to get you started:
