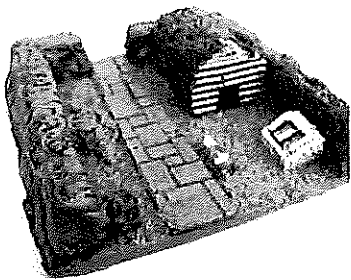

Please continue with the word lists given out last week. Ensure they can read them and know what they mean.

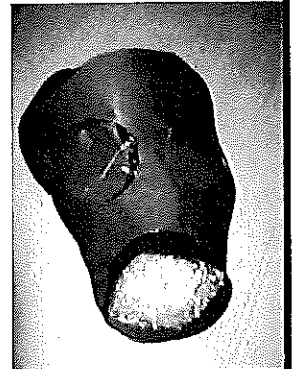
Homework Project.
