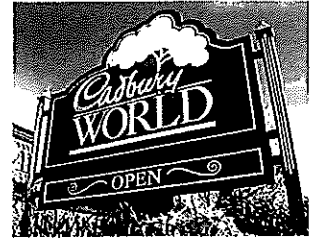
Important reminders:

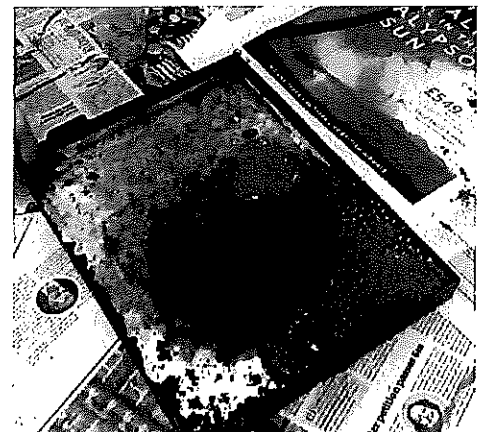
