


Year 1- Famous People: Grace Darling

Weekly Maths Tasks

- **Times Tables:** Continue to use [Times Table Rockstars](#).
- **Number Recognition:** Write a list of numbers the children see in the house and outside (e.g. door numbers, bus number etc...) and write the word to represent the number.
- **Bingo:** Play bingo using number bonds to 10 and 20.
- **Addition and Subtraction:** Give the children a number and give them several minutes to write as many addition or subtraction calculations to make that given number as they can.
- **Problem Solving:** Complete the problem below. Explain how you solved it.

In this diagram shapes represent numbers.
The sum of each row is shown on the side.
Find the value of each shape.



Weekly Reading Tasks

- **Real words/not real words:** Use Phonic Play <https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/buried-treasure> play Buried Treasure Phase 3 and 4. Segment and blend words before sorting into real or non-real words.
- **Read and watch the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch** by David and Ronda Armitage: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=46wCRq50Wwg>
- **Questions about the story:**
What is Mr Grinling's job?
What is a lighthouse?
Why are lighthouses important?
What keeps happening to Mr Grinling's lunch?
- **Book review:** Write a book review about the story and predict what they think will happen to the seagulls in the future (who's lunch will they eat next). Retell the new story in your own words.

Weekly Writing Tasks

- **Setting or place description:** Use adjectives and conjunctions to write sentences to describe Mr and Mrs Grinling's home (the lighthouse).
- **Recipe:** Write a recipe and instructions on how to make a sandwich/lunch for Mr Grinling.
- **Story - character change:** Write the story from Hamish (the cat's point of view).
- **Story -** Use the video (see project) to write about the storm and rescue as Grace Darling.

Project

- **Watch together:** <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/true-stories-grace-darling/z4y7pg8> Ask the children questions such as Who was she? Why was she famous? What made her special?
- **Fact file:** Create a fact file on Grace Darling and why she was famous.
- **Lighthouse:** Create a model of the lighthouse that Grace Darling lived in.
- **Poster:** Create a poster for RNLI (Royal National Lifeboat Institution) describing how to be safe in and around water.
