


## Year 2- Famous People: Rosa Parks

### Weekly Maths Tasks

- **Times Tables:** Continue to use [Times Table Rockstars](#).
- **Multiplication/Division:** Use a counting stick to practice counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10. Use these facts and adapt them to practice counting in steps of 20, 30, 50 and 100 etc...
- **Number facts:** Roll a dice and see how many facts the children can produce in a set time using the four operations.
- **Speedy pairs:** Match the number bonds to 10/20 using number cards.
- **Problem Solving:** Complete the problem below.

- **Questions about the story:**  
Who is Grace?  
What was special about Grace?  
Was Natalie right when they said that Grace couldn't be Peter Pan as she is black?  
What should the children have done?  
What did Grace do?
- **Favourite part:** Children shall write a description of their favourite part of the story and draw the scene.
- **Story Response:** Use programmes such as paint or create on paper to make a poster, picture or write a description on the most important idea that they want to remember from Amazing Grace.

### Weekly Writing Tasks

- **Character Description:** Write a short description on who Grace is and describe her character.
- **Short story:** Write a short story about another adventure about Grace.
- **Review:** Write a newspaper article or review describing the Peter Pan play.
- **Re-write a story:** Read and watch the story of Peter Pan and the children shall then write their own version of Peter Pan.

### Project

- **Watch together:** <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/history-ks1-ks2-rosa-parks/z7rtvk7> Ask the children questions such as Who was she? Why was she famous? What made her special?
- **Diary Entry:** Create a diary entry for Rosa Parks and her day on the bus. Focus on her feelings.
- **Portrait:** Create a portrait of Rosa Parks.
- **Letter:** Write a thank you letter to Rosa Parks that also explains what happened because of her actions.
